Rio Nights Come to Healdsburg

THREE BRAZILIAN JAZZ EVENTS

A rare opportunity to enjoy and learn more about this great music

Two of Brazil's most enduring and revered musical icons will include Healdsburg as one of their stops on their upcoming world tour this November. Internationally acclaimed jazz/samba vocalist, writer, composer and awesomely talented single-named Brazilian vocalist Joyce, and the equally accomplished guitarist and composer Dori Caymmi, will bring their considerable array of artistry northward to charm and delight the local music literati. Joyce and Caymmi will be accompanied by a quintet of Brazilian players, all of whom are superbly accomplished musicians in their own right.

Antonio Carlos Jobim once described Joyce as '...one of the greatest singers of all time.' Paris newspaper, Le Monde, says about Caymmi, '...he is one of the most influential composers of Brazilian music in the last 20 years.'

Joyce has 21 solo discs to her credit, and more than 300 of her songs and compositions recorded by some of the greatest names in Brazilian music. She has written music for movie soundtracks (Robert Altman's *The Player*, eg) and work has often been featured on films as well as television and theatrical productions.

Joining Joyce on this tour, internationally acclaimed bossa-nova innovator Dori Caymmi, is no stranger to Joyce's unique musical stylings, having worked and recorded with her on a number of occasions over the years. A man of many abilities: guitarist, vocalist, songwriter, arranger, musical director, producer - just some of the talents listed on his resume - Dori is the son of Dorival Caymmi, one of Brazil's greatest samba composers, and he's the brother of world renown singers, Nana and Danilo Caymmi.

This extremely rare opportunity to see and hear these remarkable performers on November 12 is the first segment of a three part Brazilian series being presented by the Healdsburg Jazz Festival. The second part of Rio Nights in Healdsburg will take place on December 3rd and 4th in two days of classes that will explore the roots and development, as well as the past, present and future of Brazilian music. Anyone who enjoys the pure seductiveness and the exquisite lyricism of Brazilian music will find here a virtual treasure trove of information and knowledge

The series will conclude with a performance of instrumental Brazilian Jazz at the Healdsburg Hotel on December 4th. On this Sunday Jazz Series concert, Carlos Oliveira and Brazilian Origins, featuring Harvey Wainapel, will present their band of exciting instrumental Brazilian jazz to Healdsburg audiences. Basing his music on folkloric rhythms of Northeastern Brazil, Oliveira will offer many of his own compositions while introducing audiences to a new world of festive Brazilian music. At the same time, he will add bits of flavor to his program with traditional and original sambas, bossa-novas and choros.

Brazilian Music Class: PAST, PRESENT AND FUTURE

Teacher - Harvey Wainapel

This listening class will explore the roots, development, present and future of Brazilian music. A great deal of music will be covered. Play lists will be handed out along with information on sources to buy CD's. No Musical experience required, just bring your ears and a desire to hear a lot of beautiful new music.

Saxophonist/clarinetist, Harvey Wainapel has been deeply involved with the music of Brazil for more than 20 years and has performed with some of Brazil's royalty including Airto and Flora Purim, Dori Caymmi and Hermeto Pascoal.

December 3 NOON TO 3PM

Part 1 - Choro

Choro, a unique Brazilian style of playing and performing, was born around the same time as Ragtime, with many of the same root sources-but what a difference! European classical and dance forms when mixed with the vital rhythms and melodies of Afro/Brazilian music, gave birth to a genre that sounds as alluring and vital today as it did in the beginning. A new generation is discovering this music that crosses the borders between classical, Brazilian and jazz.

Part 2 - Great Brazilian Arrangers

This section will show older folkloric sambas being transformed into more urbane, jazzy versions, arranged for guitar quartets, furiously swinging Brazilian Big Bands and more.

Parts 3 & 4, Music from the Northeast

The Northeastern region of Brazil has an extensive rich folkloric tradition, entirely different from the much more well-known sambas, bossa novas and chorors from Rio. Brazilian musicians of all styles are incorporating sounds of the Northeast into their own compositions and performances
