Festival FAQs — Frequently asked questions

How do I get to all the venues? (Note — maps are on the reverse side)

THE RAVEN THEATER From the northwest corner of the Healdsburg Plaza (Healdsburg Avenue and Plaza St.), go 1 block north to North St.; turn right on North, to 115 North Street.

HOTEL HEALDSBURG and DRY CREEK KITCHEN The Hotel and Kitchen face Healdsburg Avenue, directly across the street from the west edge of the Plaza.

RECREATION PARK

From the northwest corner of the Healdsburg Plaza (Healdsburg Avenue and Plaza St.), go 2 blocks north to the Piper Street; turn right on Piper. Go 7 blocks east to the corner of Piper St. and University Avenue. There will be entrances on both the north and south sides of the park.

FLYING GOAT COFFEE

From the northeast corner of the Healdsburg Plaza (Plaza St. and Center St.), go north to 324 Center St.

SEASONS OF THE VINEYARD

On the north side of the Healdsburg Plaza, 113 Plaza St.

TO RODNEY STRONG VINEYARDS

Coming from areas south of Healdsburg: Take Hwy 101 north to the first Healdsburg Avenue exit. At the end of the offramp, turn left (southwest) onto Old Redwood Highway. Go 1.6 mile. Turn right into the Rodney Strong parking lot at 11455 Old Redwood Highway. You will be directed where to park from there.

Coming from areas north of Healdsburg: Take Hwy 101 south to the Old Redwood Highway exit. At the end of the offramp, merge onto Old Redwood Highway, heading southwest. Go 1.6 mile. (From there follow the directions, above.)

OTHER TASTING ROOMS - Murphy-Goode, and Topel
See map on reverse. All are near the center of town.

About the outdoor venues.

Concerts go on rain or shine. Children under 10 are free at the outdoor events. No alcohol may be brought into the concerts, but wine and other beverages will be available. *No pets, no umbrellas, no chairs other than low beach chairs.* There are some shaded areas for sun protection available (varies with time of day). Please dress accordingly if hot weather is forecast. Comfortable walking shoes are recommended as some parking may be on gravel lots.

Where do I park?

When you drive up to the outdoor venues, you'll be directed where to park. There's ample free parking near the Raven Theater, the tasting rooms, in back of Hotel Healdsburg, and near Recreation Park.

When do the doors/gates open?

The Rec Park event opens promptly at noon; entrances are on both the north and south sides of the park. Rodney Strong opens one hour before show time. Indoor venues open ½ hour before showtime.

How early can I get there?

We recommend arriving ½ hour before the doors open to get a good place in line.

Can I bring food or drink?

Yes, to outdoor events only. No alcohol may be brought in to any venue, indoor or outdoor.

Will there be food and drink for purchase? Food is sold at outdoor events only. Wine, beer, and water are available for purchase at all events (no beer at Rodney Strong).

Are kids allowed? Yes, kids 10 and under are free at the outdoor events.

Cameras? Yes, to outdoor events only. There is absolutely no videotaping or audio recording allowed at any of the performances.

When will I get my tickets? Tickets are mailed within two weeks of order. If ordered within one week before the concert, your tickets will be available at the Will-Call table at each performance.

Where do I pick up Will-Call tickets? There will be a Will-Call table near the entrance at each venue.

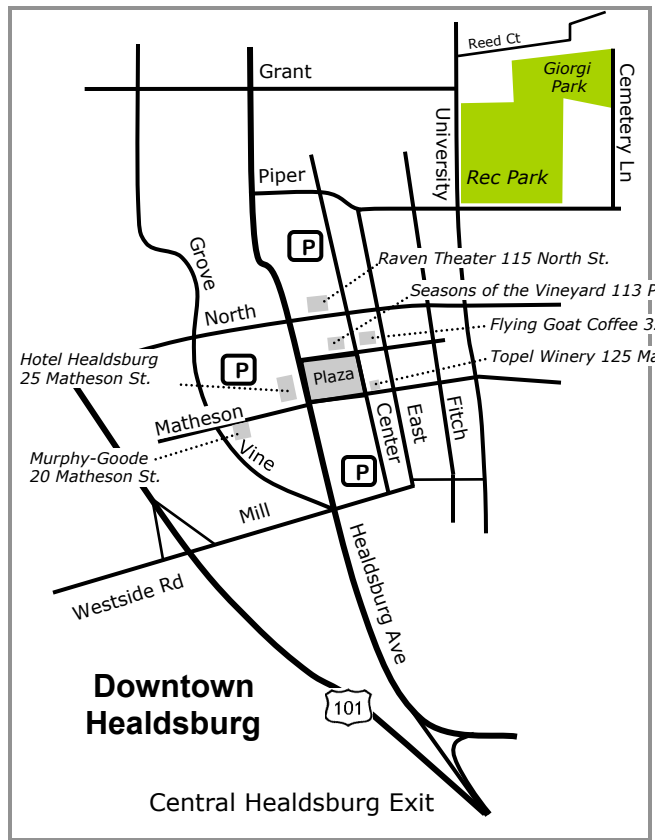
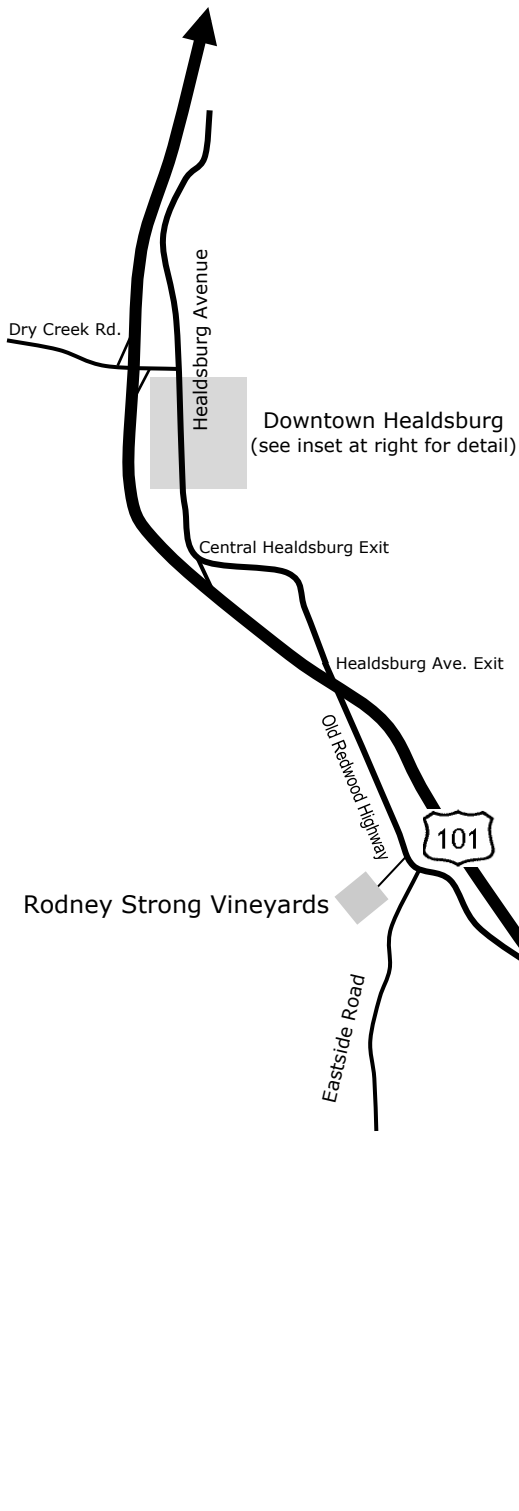
